What is SupaStrikers?

SupaStrikers is a soccer-based activity session for pre-school children aged 2-4 years. It takes the form of weekly INDOOR sessions during term time (and half term holidays at most venues). MiniStriker Sessions are 40 minutes and MegaStriker Sessions are usually 50 minutes. As well as learning core football, movement and coordination skills, we aim to help children develop their confidence, teamworking and social skills. Our equipment and programme is especially devised for the pre-school age group.

In order to provide individual attention, we work with a maximum of 10-20 per session depending on the venue size (minimum coaching ratio of 1:6). We are affiliated to Gloucestershire PATA (Playgroup and Toddler Association). Our coaching teams are fully trained, CRB-checked, and have genuine experience of working with this age group as well as football coaching skills. We hold £5m public liability insurance. Parents/Carers stay during the session, **to work with their child when necessary** AND make new friends.

Our Ethos

We believe children learn best through having fun; therefore, our sessions are lively and interactive. We also believe that stability within the group is important and operate on a membership basis, to ensure that the children see familiar faces each time. Sessions are not all about football, and there is no 'heavy' coaching. However, members will learn lots of skills that will really benefit their physical, sporting and social development in future years. Whichever session your child attends, there will be a similar type of local football activity for them to feed into, once they reach school age.

MiniStrikers and MegaStrikers

Children belong to either MiniStrikers or MegaStrikers, depending upon age and physical capability. Generally speaking, the guidelines for membership choice are as shown below:

MiniStrikers

- recommended minimum age of 2½ years old
- able to listen and respond to simple requests from another adult (with parental help if reqd)
- be confident on his/her feet

MegaStrikers

- are in their pre-school year
- are not dependent on their Carer being in constant, close proximity
- regularly attend a playgroup/similar activity

Please note, however, that merely being in his/her pre-school year does not necessarily make MegaStrikers the best option for a child, as the level of physical co-ordination, confidence and concentration required is higher than in MiniStrikers. Therefore, some children may join/continue to be a MiniStrikers even in their pre-school year. Whilst the above guidelines will help you decide in which age group to register your child, please contact us if you have any queries and we will help you make the correct decision.

Membership Details

We charge an initial enrolment fee of £15 per child (**£10 for Megas joining in Summer Term**), which includes their very own SupaStrikers football kit (please wear own 'kit' and trainers until you receive the SupaStrikers kit, and remember to bring a non-fizzy drink each week). Upon enrolment, members also pay for 6 weeks in advance (at £4.50 per session) plus their enrolment fee (or for the whole Summer Term if a Mega joining after the Easter Holidays). If we offer you an initial trial session, you will be asked to pay £4.50 if your child joins in all/most of the trial session – this is then deducted from the overall initial fee if you decide to join. For subsequent re-registrations, members pay for 8 weeks at the standard rate of £5.50 per session. Although we do not run during main school holidays, sessions already paid for are simply carried forward into the next term (**NB that some Sessions DO run during half term holidays, except on Bank Holiday weekends**). Members are notified automatically when renewal of membership fees is due.

In each block of sessions booked, members are able to have ONE 'credit' where a session is missed for any reason, **provided that we are informed before the session is due to start (except in emergencies), by one of the following methods ONLY** (email info@supastrikers.co.uk or phone/text 07769 894138). A credited session is 'added on' at the end of your current block of sessions, before we invoice again.

Parents of all new members enrolling **MUST** complete an enrolment form and agree to abide by the membership rules which are published with the enrolment form. Owing to insurance stipulations, only children for whom we have received a completed enrolment form may participate in SupaStrikers sessions. All payment must be in advance, although we operate a 'money back guarantee' when you first join (see membership rules). We will **provisionally hold a place for up to seven days**, but will release it without further notice if the enrolment form and payment have not been received (unless otherwise agreed).

Where necessary, a **waiting list** will operate for sessions. If a Session is already fully booked when we receive your enrolment form and payment, we will contact you and offer you either an alternate Session or a priority place on the waiting list. *We will not bank your payment until a definite place has been offered and accepted.*

Membership Rules & Enrolment Form

Membership Rules

- 1 Definitions: 'Parent' - Any person with overall parental responsibility for the Member (including those not named below)
'Carer' - Person AGED 18+ YEARS with parental responsibility for the Member at the time of the session
'Member' - Pre-school child who is enrolled and attends Sessions
'Coach' - Person employed or licensed by SupaStrikers to be responsible for leading a Session
'Session' - 40-50 minute period (depending upon session) during which Members are supervised by Coaches
- 2 Enrolling a Member indicates acceptance by the Parent of the terms and conditions outlined in this document.
- 3 The Parent shall pay the full fee due (as advised by SupaStrikers) PRIOR to the Member attending sessions which have not been paid for. Exceptions to this must have been agreed in advance with SupaStrikers. Owing to insurance requirements, Coaches will not allow any child to participate unless an enrolment form has been completed. Following a Member's first participative Session, if the course is agreed to not be suitable a full refund of enrolment fee and remaining Sessions will be made under our **Money-Back Guarantee** within 28 days, provided that SupaStrikers are notified in writing/email within 7days of this first session. If your child attends a 'trial' session before full payment is made, the Money-Back Guarantee will not apply. **Once a block of sessions has been paid for**, SupaStrikers will not refund remaining fees if you decide to stop attending, although we may, at our discretion, offer to suspend a membership without forfeiture of remaining sessions.
- 4 The SupaStrikers football kit is issued on a Member's second Session (or as soon after this as is reasonably practical). Once it has been issued, the enrolment fee will not be refunded in any circumstances. (except under the terms of the initial money back guarantee). However, if we can re-sell your place, any resold sessions will be refunded and there may be other exceptional circumstances e.g. long term medical conditions, family bereavement in which we will also offer a refund.
- 5 The Carer MUST remain on site for the duration of the session and is ultimately responsible for the Member's behaviour, participation, safety and welfare (including ALL toilet or bathroom visits). The Parent will ensure that any changes to the information on the enrolment form are notified in writing as soon as reasonably possible. The Parent agrees that other than in the event of negligence by a Coach(es), insurance against personal injury or loss/damage is the responsibility of the Parent. **Please note that SupaStrikers are only responsible for Members whilst the Session is actually in progress - please ensure that you properly supervise your child BEFORE and AFTER the Session.**
- 6 If a Member or Carer's behaviour is deemed unacceptable, SupaStrikers reserves the right to suspend or permanently exclude either from future sessions, with no refund of fees paid. In such situations, SupaStrikers will aim to discuss the situation with the Parent and seek a solution, before such action is taken.
- 7 The Parent agrees that a Member or Carer will NOT ATTEND if either has a significant, infectious medical condition.
- 8 The Parent will reimburse any reasonable costs incurred by SupaStrikers, as a result of the actions of either Member/Carer.
- 9 SupaStrikers reserve the right to cancel/postpone a course before or during membership. A full refund will be given for sessions not completed, but SupaStrikers will have no other liability owing. Occasionally, a Session may be unable to run on a specific date(s) owing to unavailability of the venue or Coaches; we will give you as much notice of this as reasonably possible.
- 10 The Parent agrees not to establish, provide information regarding SupaStrikers to, or be employed by a similar sports-based activity for pre-school children for a period of two years after SupaStrikers membership ceases (without written consent).
